The depth of their misunderstanding is revealed in what they discuss as they walk along the way: which of them is the greatest. Jesus must have been horrified. Have they learned nothing of his humble, gentle way? Have they not yet grasped that the path to greatness in the kingdom leads downward toward suffering, self-renun-ciation, and service, rather than upward toward good reputations and worldly glory? To teach them, he centers attention on a child, a person of the lowest social status in that society.

But it is these — the lost and the least-who are counted great in God's economy.

James writes to Christians scattered throughout the Roman Empire, warning them against jealousy and selfish ambition. "Ask and it will be given to you," promised Jesus (Mt 7:7). But James tells his listeners, "You ask but do not receive." Why? Because they ask God to assist them in their war against one another; they make requests out of ambitious desires rather than from peace, mercy, and gentleness.


