It is not surprising that the disciples were indignant at James and John. How bold to ask for seats of honor in heaven! If we are honest with ourselves, however, these disciples are asking for the same things most people desire. Perhaps they simply wish to be acknowledged for their dedication to Jesus.

Jesus does not scold James and John when they boldly tell him that they want him to do whatever they ask. Instead, he simply asks them what they wish to do. Of course, Jesus knows what they want. He is the high priest who sympathizes with our weaknesses and waits eagerly for us to approach his throne of grace for mercy and help. They ask Jesus to grant them —literally, give them-the two highest places of honor in the kingdom. Jesus replies that what he has to give is not what they expect. Jesus gathers his disciples and tells them how they will be different from all other people. Instead of lording prestige over one another, they will lower themselves. The highest place of honor is not next to the king at the banquet table but on the floor with the lowest servants, kneeling to wash the dirty feet of the guests.

What Jesus has to give them turns out to be himself. He "did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." This fulfills Isaiah's prophecy that "through his suffering, my servant shall justify many."


